FAQs

Q. How long is the waitlist?

A. Wait times vary due to fluctuations in student interest. You will accept your position on the waitlist WHEN all admissions items are completed. Wait times can be greater than 6 Months. If you have completed all admissions items contact admissions@nwtc.edu for your tentative start time.

Q. What is the schedule?

A. The Nursing Bridge program is available part time only. There is a part time day, evening, or weekend option. Due to variations in clinical availability and days/times we are unable to provide exact days and times until closer to the start of clinicals. You can expect to be on campus up to 2 days/nights per week.

Q. What if I have transfer credits?

A. A transfer review is automatically completed AFTER you have applied AND submitted your transcripts. If you had fewer then 60 college credits at a C or higher, you must also send your high school transcripts. It can take up to 2 weeks for transfer credits to be processed. If you have completed Nursing CORE courses at another college, you must be in good standing and core courses are reviewed for approval by the health division.
